Here's what you need to register!

The complete Registration Packet includes **General Information** on this year's Sport Stacking Championships as well as **Registration Forms** and information for **Volunteering**. Feel free to make as many copies as needed for your stackers and parents.

Important Info:

- ◆ **BE AWARE OF THE WSSA SPORT STACKING RULES!** This will help all stackers, coaches, and parents with any confusion regarding stacking and tournament procedures.
- ◆ **"AGE LEVEL" DIVISIONS FOR ALL EVENTS!**
A stacker's Age Division coincides with their age on the day of the tournament (March 10th). Stackers will compete in the following Age Divisions—4 & under, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, Collegiate (19-24), Masters Divisions (25-34, 35-44, 45-59) and Seniors (60 & above). Special Stackers will compete in the following Age Divisions—6 & under, 7-10, 11-14, 15-18 and Open (19 & above), in one of two levels.
- ◆ **ALL STACKERS CAN COMPETE IN:** the three **INDIVIDUAL** events (3-3-3, 3-6-3 and Cycle Stacks), the **DOUBLES** competition (regular and Parent-Child) and the **TEAM RELAY** event (the Timed 3-6-3 Relay)
- ◆ **STACK-OFF** featuring the 3 stackers from Indiana with the fastest overall times (from the finals.) They will be competing for special prizes and a chance to be called the "FASTEST IN INDIANA."
- ◆ We are expecting **more than 200 Stackers** from Indiana, Ohio, Kentucky, and more! Championships are open to everyone!
- ◆ This year's **Registration fee is \$25** per stacker. A **General Admission** fee will be charged at the door for all spectators. (Competitors & Volunteers are FREE!)
- ◆ The Connersville/Fayette County Chamber of Commerce can help you find **hotel arrangements, as well as dining, shopping, and area attractions**. Please access their website at www.connersvillechamber.com. Look for the tourism link on their Home Page.

COACH'S MEETING:

- MEET IN THE CONCESSIONS AREA AT 9:30 FOR AN INFORMATIONAL MEETING.
- STACKERS MAY BE PRACTICING AT THE WARM-UP TABLES DURING THIS TIME; NO ONE IS TO BE USING THE COMPETITION TABLES.

PRELIMS (INDIVIDUAL, DOUBLES, AND TIMED RELAYS):

- TIME SHEETS NEED TO GO WITH THEM TO THE COMPETITION FLOOR.
- STACKERS LINE UP AT THE ON-DECK TABLES. **ONCE THEY START THEIR WARM-UP AT THE ON-DECK TABLE, THEY ARE COMMITTED TO GO TO THE COMPETITION TABLE NEXT.**
- **PRELIMS CAN BE DONE AT ANY TABLE REGARDLESS OF THE STACKER'S AGE-GROUP TABLE.**
- STACKERS NEED TO GIVE THEIR PRELIM TIME SHEET TO THE JUDGE AT THE COMPETITION TABLE.
- THE JUDGE WILL KEEP THE PRELIM TIME SHEET AFTER ALL 3 STACKS ARE COMPLETED.
- INDIVIDUAL PRELIMS NEED TO BE COMPLETED BY 11:30. DOUBLES AND TIMED RELAY PRELIMS WILL BE FROM 11:30 – 12:15.

FINALS (INDIVIDUAL, DOUBLES, AND TIMED RELAYS):

- INDIVIDUAL FINALS WILL BE HELD BEGINNING AT 12:30. THE ORDER IS LISTED IN THE SCHEDULE.
- **RESULTS FROM PRELIMS WILL BE POSTED. THE TOP 10 IN EACH DIVISION IN EACH OF THE 3 INDIVIDUAL EVENTS QUALIFY FOR FINALS.**
- ALL AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN AT THE CONCLUSION OF EACH FINALS EVENT AT THE RESPECTIVE AGE-GROUP TABLE.

- FINALS WILL BE DONE AT EACH STACKER'S AGE-GROUP TABLE.
- ONLY THOSE WHO HAVE QUALIFIED FOR THE FINALS MAY BE ON THE STACKING COURT DURING THIS TIME.

STACK-OFF:

- COACHES, STACKERS, AND SPECTATORS NEED TO GATHER IN THE BLEACHERS AND AROUND THE STACKING COURT AT 3:45 FOR THE STACK-OFF.
- THE 3 STACKERS FROM **INDIANA** WITH THE FASTEST OVERALL TIMES (FROM THE FINALS) WILL BE ANNOUNCED AND CALLED FORWARD TO COMPETE IN THE STACK-OFF.
- THEY WILL DO ALL 3 INDIVIDUAL STACKS AGAIN, FOLLOWING THE SAME PROCEDURE AS USED IN FINALS.
- AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE "FASTEST IN INDIANA"
- AT THIS TIME, WE WILL ALSO RECOGNIZE OUR TEAM USA STACKERS AND HAVE THEM DO A DEMONSTRATION IF TIME ALLOWS.

Volunteer Information

The success of the WSSA Hoosier Sport Stacking Championships relies greatly on the number of volunteers helping out on the day of the event. We anticipate more than 200 competitors, and we need more than 50 volunteers. No experience is necessary, just some enthusiasm and a willingness to help out.

Who can volunteer?

School staff members, parents, guardians, grandparents, middle and high school students (**it's a great community service opportunity**), friends and neighbors.

What is the time commitment?

We're flexible! Just indicate your availability on the Volunteer Registration Form, and you'll be contacted with your specific time and duties. **All-day volunteers will receive free admission, and free lunch and snacks in our Hospitality Room!!**

What jobs are available?

25 Judges are needed for the Hoosier Championships. Work whatever fits your schedule. **You will work with another Judge, so you do not have to go it alone.** No previous experience is needed, however, training is necessary (*please see below*).

10 Workers for the Coach & Stacker Check in on Saturday morning.

10 Data Entry Workers. This group will enter competition data throughout the day. Some computer skills are necessary. Will train! This is really fun!

8 Adult or Youth Runners during the Prelims, to collect result sheets from Judges and bring them to the Leader Board area, plus help us by running water and supplies to the Judges and other Officials.

10 Volunteer Hospitality Room Hosts needed to monitor the volunteer's snack room.

12 Videographers to video tape the finals (required for State/Provincial, National and World Records to be set).

5 Information Aides to work at the Information/Volunteer Check-in Table assisting volunteers, managing lost and found, and answering questions.

15 Set-Up Crew Members needed at Expo Hall the Thursday prior to the event.

15 Clean-Up Crew Members to tear down and straighten things up on Saturday after the event.

*Definition of a Special Stacker: A "Special Stacker" is one that has a diagnosed Physical and/or Mental disability that would impede with the "normal" functioning necessary to perform a variety of physical skills. A Special Stacker must be identified by an agency or professional as having one of the following conditions: intellectual disabilities, cognitive delays as measured by formal assessment, or significant learning or vocational problems due to cognitive delay that require or have required specially designed instruction.

Special Stackers will qualify to compete in one of two "Levels" in their age division. We have patterned qualifying for each Level after the Individual competition itself. We ask that an adult oversee (or time) the Stacker for three tries, record each time in the spaces below and then fill in the Best Time. If using a StackMat, the Stacker will start and stop the timer and correct all fumbles. If using a stopwatch the Stacker should: start with hands flat on the table; have no false starts; correct all fumbles; and be timed to the 1/100 of a second. Timer says "Ready...Get Set...Go!" and starts the stopwatch on the word "Go".
