When your team is not competing, go take part in the interactive stacking stations on the Concourse. Family members welcome to participate!



## Saturday, April 10th

### ✓ Verify contents of this packet

- Quick Guide, Coach badge (your pass to get down on the arena floor)
- Participant Lapel Pins for you and your team members (their passes)
- Preprinted Prelim Time Sheets: Individual, Doubles and Timed 3-6-3 Relay and "My Best Time" sheet for each team member
- Team Sign (to be used in the On Deck Area during H-T-H Relays)
- Judges Tips & Procedures – use these for easy reference to understand all competition.
- Map of Competition Area & directions to Optional Relay Team Coaches Q & A meeting
- Program
- Voucher for Relay Team Volunteer Reimbursement Program (if applicable)

### ✓ Gather your Team

- Enter the arena and find a place for your team to sit down. Look for the section that corresponds to your teams division.
- Sit in rows behind spectator rows of your Age Division. (NOTE: Spectators only in first 4-5 rows.)
- Stackers may warm-up at On Deck Tables on arena floor and Warm-Up Tables on Concourse, but not at the Competition Tables.

### Sunday Finals Qualifiers

There are four ways to learn if your team members have qualified for the Finals on Sunday.

1. Big Screen Leader Board
2. Concourse TV monitors
3. Finals Qualifier Board (at center of arena floor)
4. Posted on WSSA website Saturday night – [www.worldsportstackingassociation.org](http://www.worldsportstackingassociation.org)

## 9:00-11:30am Prelims (OPTION 1) Individual, Doubles & Timed 3-6-3 Relays

- DO NOT LOSE the time sheets – they are your official time sheets. These have been pre-printed with the Stacker's name, division and school. If this information is incorrect, please mark up the time sheet with corrections. Verify Birthdates too.
- Stackers line up at the On Deck Tables. Once they start their warm-up at On Deck Table they are committed to go to the Competition Table next.  
Note: PRELIMS MAY BE DONE AT **ANY** DIVISION.
- Each Stacker gives their Prelim Time Sheet and "My Best Times" Sheet to the Judge at the Competition Table.
- The Judge will keep the Prelim Time Sheet and return the "My Best Times" Sheet to the Stacker.
- If possible, have your team complete all Prelim events during this time. NOTE: Timed 3-6-3 Relay Prelims must be completed by 12:45pm!

## 10:00-10:30am Optional Relay Team Coaches Q & A Meeting (on top, west side above Section 2)

For Coaches only. Please have a parent from your team supervise your Stackers at this time.

## 11:30-11:45am Opening Ceremonies (At center of arena on backside of stage in front of Awards)

Teams are encouraged to sit on arena floor facing Awards Table to enjoy ceremonies.

## 11:45am-1:45pm H-T-H 3-6-3 Relays (3-3-3 for 6U) Prelims (OPTION 2)

- Division Managers will introduce themselves and call down all Relay Team Coaches for a brief pre-tournament meeting. Take roll, hand out brackets.
- First teams called down to Competition Tables.
- Subsequent teams will be called to the "On Deck Tables" where they can warm up.
- Coach hold up your Team Sign (in packet). GIVE THE SIGN TO THE JUDGE BEFORE EACH MATCH.
- Shake hands, high fives, etc. before and after each match. Each match is best 2 out of 3 races.
- Return to your seats in the stands between matches.
- Top 4 teams are awarded immediately after final match. If you're one of these teams DO NOT LEAVE until you've received your awards.
- Teams eliminated should complete all Prelims if they haven't already done so at Concourse Competition Area (in SE corner behind Section 14) or at any Competition Table not being used for H-T-H Relays. **Don't forget StackFest!**  
NOTE: Timed 3-6-3 Relay Prelims END at 12:45 pm. Individual & Doubles END at 1:45 pm.

## 12:30-1:30pm Finals: Special Stackers (Individual, Doubles & Timed 3-6-3 Relay)

- At Special Stackers Division.
- After Awards are presented here, all Special Stackers and their families will immediately move over to Awards Table at center of arena for a special recognition.

Saturday, April 10th (cont.)

### 1:45-3:15pm H-T-H Cycle Relays (3-6-3 for 6U)

- Have your team sit in stands overlooking your Division.
- Division Manager will give a short briefing to all coaches--roll call and hand out brackets. (Teams have been "seeded" in their brackets based on Timed 3-6-3 Relay Prelims.)
- Follow same procedures as in H-T-H 3-6-3 Relay (3-3-3 for 6U) except please note: This is a SINGLE ELIMINATION format.
- Final 4 teams will move on for two semi-final matches, one consolation for 3rd & 4th places and one Final match to determine 1st and 2nd.
- These top 4 teams will be given their awards immediately at their Division.

**NOTE: The final match of the 6U H-T-H 3-6-3 Relay will be run on Sunday at the Stack of Champions.**

### 3:45-4:45pm SPEED STACKS International Challenge (Preliminary Matches, on stage)

- You and your team and their families are invited to "pack Sections 10-12" and watch the top teams from around the world represent their countries in this special international event!

### 4:45-5:30pm Open Division (19 & Above) H-T-H Relays (On stage, 3-6-3 then Cycle)

## Sunday, April 11th *Good luck, and please help to keep the Finals a positive day for all.*

### 8:00am Doors open

**For Finals locations, see "Finals Competition Maps."**

**Note:** Individual Event Finals for Age Divisions 5, 15, 16, & 17 take place in Hamilton Gymnasium.

### 8:00-8:40am Warm up for Finals

- Only stackers who qualified for today's Finals may warm up at On Deck Tables on arena floor or at concourse Warm Up Tables, not the Competition Tables.

### 8:45-9:15am Finals: Timed 3-6-3 Relay

- Top 4 teams from Prelims in each division qualify for these Finals (Listed on Leader Board) They will be called down.
- Places 1-4 are awarded immediately at their Division. Clear the floor.

### 9:15-9:45am Finals: Doubles (Age Division)

- Top 5 teams from Prelims in each division qualify for these Finals (Listed on Leader Board). They will be called down.
- Places 1-5 are awarded immediately at their Division. Clear the floor.

### 9:45-10:15am Finals: Individual 3-3-3

### 10:15-11:00am Finals: Individual 3-6-3

• Top 10 Finalists in each Division from the Prelims in each of the three Individual events qualify for these Finals (See Leader Board). They will be called down on to the floor by their Division Manager.

• Places 1-10 awarded immediately at their Division.

### 11:00am-Noon Finals: Individual Cycle

### Noon-12:30pm Finals: Doubles (Child/Parent)

- Top 5 teams from Prelims in the Child/Parent division qualify for these finals (Listed on Leader Board). They will be called down.
- Places 1-5 are awarded immediately. Clear the floor.

### 12:30-1:00pm Lunch Break, Preparation for STACK of CHAMPIONS

- 12:35 pm-Qualifiers (Announced on Leader Board) meet at center of Arena floor.
- Spectators get their seats in Sections 10-12.

### 1:00-3:00pm STACK of CHAMPIONS (Cheer on the top stackers of the tournament!)
