After Check-In:

• If you pre-ordered a shirt, go to the T-shirt booth and pick up all of the shirts that you pre-ordered.

• Enter the Gym and find a place to sit down, look for the section that corresponds to your age division. (*Stackers* may warmup at the official Warm-Up Tables lining the back gym walls-however, they will not be equipped with Stackmats-you are welcomed to bring your own. On-deck tables within the competition area are off limits until competition begins. The SpeedStacks Store and Kitchen area for refreshments will open once the Prelims begin.

8:00am - 8:15am: Opening Introductions

• Move up into the stands for the National Anthem and a quick preview of what to expect during the day.

8:15am – 9:30am: Individual Prelims.

• **DO NOT LOSE** the enclosed time sheet – it is your official time sheet. It has been pre-printed with the participants' name, age division and school. If this information is incorrect, please mark corrections on the time sheet.

• Stackers enter competition area and practice on the On Deck Tables. Once they start their warm-up at the On Deck Table they are committed to go to the Competition Table next. The order of events is as follows: 3-3-3, 3-6-3, Cycle...a stacker completes all stacks while at that table before leaving.

• Each Stacker gives their time sheet to the Judge when they stack for their official time.

• The Judge will NOT give this time sheet back to the Stackers (each Stacker will receive a yellow "My Best Times" sheet to keep).

9:45am – 10:45am: Timed Relay Events-Prelims and Finals

• Move up into the stands and enjoy the relays.

10:45am-11:15am: Doubles Prelims.

<u>11:15pm – 11:45pm:</u> Lunch Break for all Stackers and Judges.

12:00pm – 1:30pm Individual and Doubles Finals & Awards

- Places 1-5 meet at your Division Table for the Finals.
- Places 1-5 stack for the Finals and are awarded immediately in their Division.

• If you are involved in the Finals, make sure you are present and available (Check the Leader Board for the top five final participants in each age division).

1:30pm – 2:00pm STACK OF CHAMPONS

• The Top 3 overall in all three stacks compete one last time to possibly break State, National, and World Records!!!!! <u>2:00pm-2:30pm Awards Ceremony</u>

Top 5 in each stack receive awards.....with the top 3 overall in the entire tournament also receiving awards!!!!
We will try our best to stay within this time schedule-but be prepared for delays-or beginning events early......Sport Stacking can be unpredictable...... so bear with us.
