Important Info:

◆ BE AWARE OF THE WSSA SPORT STACKING RULES! The new timing and age-division rules will be used for this event. This will help all stackers, coaches, and parents with any confusion regarding stacking and tournament procedures.

◆ "AGE LEVEL" DIVISIONS FOR ALL EVENTS!

A stacker's Age Division coincides with their age on the day of the tournament (October 17th). Age and gender divisions will be determined and set when there is a clearer picture of how many stackers are registered to compete.

◆ALL STACKERS CAN COMPETE IN: the three INDIVIDUAL events (3-3-3, 3-6-3 and Cycle Stacks, Individual Head to Head tournament, and the Pursuit Challenge), the DOUBLES competition (regulation and Parent-Child) and the TEAM RELAY event (the Timed 3-6-3 Relay)

◆ ◆ This year's Registration fee is \$25 per stacker. A General Admission fee will be charged at the door for all spectators, kids 5 and under free.

- STACKERS NEED TO GIVE THEIR PRELIM TIME SHEET TO THE JUDGE AT THE COMPETITION TABLE.
- THE JUDGE WILL KEEP THE PRELIM TIME SHEET AFTER ALL 3 STACKS ARE COMPLETED.
- INDIVIDUAL PRELIMS NEED TO BE COMPLETED BY 11:00. DOUBLES AND TIMED RELAY PRELIMS WILL BE FROM 11:00 11:50.
