Tournament information:

- Everyone who's interested can participate
- Sanctioned by the WSSA (records can be Anerkennung von Rekorden möglich)
- Part of the Overall Champion Series
- The tournament persists of a prelim round, a final round and the "Stack of Champions" for the following disciplines: 3-3-3, 3-6-3, Cycle, Doubles, Parent-Child-Doubles, Timed 3-6-3 Relay; additionally a "Mystery Event" if there's enough time

Registration:

- You can register via the <u>WSSA-online-registration-form</u> under <u>www.thewssa.com</u>; individual starters without WSSA-account send their registration with all the needed information (name, birth date and disciplines) to <u>sstq@sstq.de</u>
- The <u>1st registration deadline</u> ends on <u>September 6th of 2025</u>.
 The <u>2nd registration deadline</u> ends on <u>September 13th of 2025</u>
- Registrations which are sent between September 15th and September 21st will only be accepted with doubled registration fee
- After the 1st registration deadline, a list of all participants will be published online, so
 that participants without a doubles partner or relay team can still look for partners.
 Who doesn't look for a partner by himself/herself, he/she can be paired with
 someone else by the organizer!
- Doubles and relay teams can be registered until the 2nd registration deadline (send information to sstq@sstq.de)
- Groups should send the registrations of their club members combined by the club leader

Registration fee:

- The registration fee costs **15 Euro** for all disciplines
- For parents, the participation in Parent/Child-doubles is free
- Registration fee won't be refunded when someone is registered but doesn't participate

Payment and pickup of documents:

- The registration fee has to be paid at the tournament in cash
- Club leaders should pick up the documents of their participants all together

Planned Awards:

- Individuals: in the age divisions up to 14 years and in the Special Stackers division, the top 3 stackers of every discipline (3-3-3, 3-6-3, Cycle) will be awarded; in the age divisions from 15 years and above, the top 3 stackers of the All Around will be awarded
- Doubles & C/P-Doubles: in every age division, the top 3 doubles will be awarded
- Timed Relay: in every age division, the top 3 teams will be awarded

Planned Prelims:

- The prelims for Individuals should be judged beforehand by qualified judges in the clubs and sent to sstq@sstq.de until September 23th of 2025
- Prelims times of age division with more than 10 participants have to be judged at the tournament. Participants who are affected will be informed after the 2nd registration deadline
- Prelims times for Doubles and Timed 3-6-3 Relay have to be judged at the tournament
- If you aren't able to do your Individual prelims beforehand, please let us know

Judges:

• Every experienced participant can be asked to judge for a smooth tournament process. A timetable for judges will be published a few days before the tournament.

Equipment:

 At the tournament, you can only use original Speed Stacks. The G5-timer will be used. Mats and timers at the final tables will be placed by the organizer; for the warmup area, you have to bring your own equipment

Rules and audio/video-recordings:

 With the registration, the participant (or their parents for underaged participants) accepts the rules of the tournament. He/She also accepts that he/she can be audioor video-recorded.

Shoes:

• In the tournament hall, you have to wear sport shoes!

Food/Drinks:

- At the tournament, we're going to offer buns, salads and some snacks; for drinks, we're going to offer water, coffee and softdrinks; we're also planning hotdogs for lunch
- Please pay the food and drinks in a donation can in your sole discretion
- Please bring your own dishes and drinking cups if possible
- As an alternative, the center of Quickborn can be reached within 10 minutes where you can find bakeries, super markets, some restaurants, kebab shops, an ice cream parlor, etc.
- !! If you have some intolerances, please inform the tournament director or be responsible for your own catering

Accidents/Stealing:

• The organizer doesn't take responsibility for any accidents or stealings.

Arriving:

- Per car: A7-exit "Quickborn", following the streets "Friedrichsgaber Straße",
 "Bahnstraße" and "Ellerauer Straße" to Quickborn. Go right at the "Ziegenweg" and drive to the big car park
- Per train:

From Hamburg coming, you have to go by train (S3 or S5) until the station "Eidelstedt". Change there for the A1 and go to "Quickborn".

- From the north coming, for example go to "Neumünster", change into the A2 and go to the station "Ulzburg Süd". Change there into the A1 and go to "Quickborn".
- Because of long time constructions, there's the chance for rail replacement bus service. Please consider more time for your travel plannings.

- Doubles and Relay:
 - Pairings with participants who are all 18 years or younger will participate in the age division of the oldest participant
 - Pairings with participants who are all 19 years or older will participate in the age division of the youngest participant
- Pairings with participants who are 18 or younger and participants who are 19 or older will be participate in the "Open" division

Qualification for finals:

- Individuals: The **best 10 stackers** of the prelims round
- Doubles: The **best 5 pairings** of the prelims round
- Parent-Child-Doubles: The **best 10 pairings** of the prelims round
- Timed 3-6-3 Relay: The **best 4 teams** of the prelims round
